Payment

- ☆ To take advantage of our Early Bird discount - all payment must be received by April 1, 2010.
- ☆ We gladly accept Visa, MasterCard, American Express, checks and Cash. A non-refundable \$50 per week deposit is required to reserve a space for your child. This will be applied to camp fees.
- ☆ The balance of all tuition is due by June 1, 2010. After June 1, tuition is due at time of enrollment if space is available.
- ☆ No refund can be given after the scheduled program / session begins.
- ☆ There will be no refunds or make-up days for absences.
- ☆ We reserve the right to cancel classes due to insufficient enrollment.

Pick-up Policy

All classes end at 12 noon. The hour between 12 noon and 1:00 pm is a “bonus hour.” Children are welcome and encouraged to stay, eat their home packed lunch, play games and have free time- all under the watchful eyes of our summer camp staffers. Parents are welcome to pick-up their child/ren anytime during this hour. Pick up will take place on the AACA playground (Greenview) with a designated Smarty Party staff member signing out all kids daily. All students must be picked up by 1:00 pm. Please notify us as soon as possible if you are running late. In the event you are more than 10 minutes late, you will be charged \$1 per minute for late pick ups.
